## ABOUT THE COLLABORATING INSTITUTIONS

### Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, Coimbatore

Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, commonly known as Amrita University, is a private deemed university in India. It is a multi-campus, multi-disciplinary university with its headquarters located in Ettimadai, Coimbatore. It constitutes of 8 campuses with 18 constituent states schools across India, namely Amaravati, Amritapuri, Bangalore, Chennai, Coimbatore, Kochi, Mysore, and Faridabad. The university spans over 1,200 acres with more than 10 million square feet of built-up space. Accredited with 'A++' grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It offers more than 250 undergraduate, integrated, dual-degree, postgraduate, PG diploma, doctorate, post-doctorate, clinical, certificate, and online courses in Engineering, Management, Medical Sciences, Ayurveda, Sciences, Architecture and Planning, Arts, Humanities, Philosophy, Performing Arts, and Social and Behavioral Sciences.

### Gandhigram Rural Institute, Gandhigram

Gandhigram Rural Institute had its genesis on 7<sup>th</sup> October, 1947 and it progressed and expanded remarkably in the areas of rural community development under the dynamic leadership of its founders Dr.G.Ramachandran and Dr.T.S.Soundaram Ramachandran, dedicated disciples of Gandhiji. Drawing huge inspiration from work and ideas of Mahatma Gandhi, they worked with enormous amount of zeal and commitment for the betterment of the rural people in the vicinity and it was their unstinting dedication and unwavering faith in Gandhian ideals that has made Gandhigram what it is today. The Gandhigram Rural Institute of Higher Education was started in 1956 to bring higher education closer to the villagers. The significant educational experiment, broadly conforming to the recommendations of the Radhakrishnan Commission relating to rural universities and rural colleges, was inaugurated by Dr.Rajendra Prasad, the first President of India on August 1956. The first academic block of Gandhigram Rural Institute was inaugurated by the first Prime Minister of India, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru on December, 1957. Right from its inception, the Institute is fully funded by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

### Indian Adult Education Association (IAEA), New Delhi

is an established NGO with more than 85 years of standing in the field of Adult and Lifelong Education. The main objective of the Association is to support the government's efforts to eradicate illiteracy through publications, by organizing meetings, seminars and conferences. The founding fathers of this institution were men of eminence including Dr. Zakir Hussain who was the Vice President of this organization from 1950 to 1960. The Association is located in its own building at Indraprastha Estate, New Delhi for which a neo-literate laid the foundation stone in the presence of Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru in 1957 and the building was inaugurated by him only in 1961.

### Shanti Ashram, Coimbatore

Shanti Ashram is a Creative Laboratory where the problems faced by our communities can be both identified and provided with constructive solutions. Our spiritual motivation inspires us to be engaged in social action. Inspired by Mahatma Gandhi's vision of Sarvodaya, the Ashram was founded in 1986 by Dr. Aram and Mrs. Minoti Aram, along with Fellow Gandhians. Locally, Shanti Ashram's work reaches the lives of nearly 250,000 people in the immediate service area. Standing alongside this service outreach, Shanti Ashram works in collaborative mode with over 215 institutions at global and local level. All of them are committed members of the partnership platform established as part of the Silver Jubilee Celebrations of Shanti Ashram.
