WHY THIS OD INITIATIVE?

India's quest for sustainable development and democratic governance is challenged by growing inequalities, changing climate, and mounting exclusion. The non-profit sector is confronted with multi-faceted challenges including access to flexible resources and spaces. Effective contributions of the non-profits in promoting empowerment and participation of the marginalised communities depend on the organisations' ability to become more agile, adaptive, and strategic. However, an enabling support and facilitation ecosystem for Non-profits is largely missing in India. This initiative will address this gap by training a pool of professionals who are capable of providing OD support to grassroots non-profits.

HOW WILL YOUR LEARNING PERFORMANCE BE MEASURED?

- Attendance in the sessions (weightage 20)
- Quality of participation in the sessions (online and face-to-face) and online discussion forums (weightage 20)
- Quality of engagement with the host organisation during practicum (weightage 20)
- Quality of submitted assignments (weightage 40)

The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) will be used for each component of the course – online reading and workshops, two residential workshops and practicum.

An average total CGPA will be calculated to assess the overall performance, post which participant would receive their certificate.

WHAT SPECIFIC COMPETENCIES WILL YOU LEARN FROM THE COURSE?

By familiarising yourself thoroughly with an understanding of the organisational framework along with other OD theories and practices in non-profits, you will be able to facilitate:

- ▶ a participatory organisational assessment to identify OD needs of the non-profit
- ▶ (re)formulate gender inclusive vision, mission and strategies based on external and internal assessments
- ▶ (re)design an appropriate organisational structure for the effective implementation of strategies and programmes
- ▶ developing a planning, monitoring, and evaluation (PME) framework for impact-driven outcome-based programmes with stakeholder engagement
- ▶ designing organisational policies and processes that support the empowerment of human talents and make organisations gender transformative
- ▶ creating mechanisms for the continuous development of transparent and accountable leadership and governance

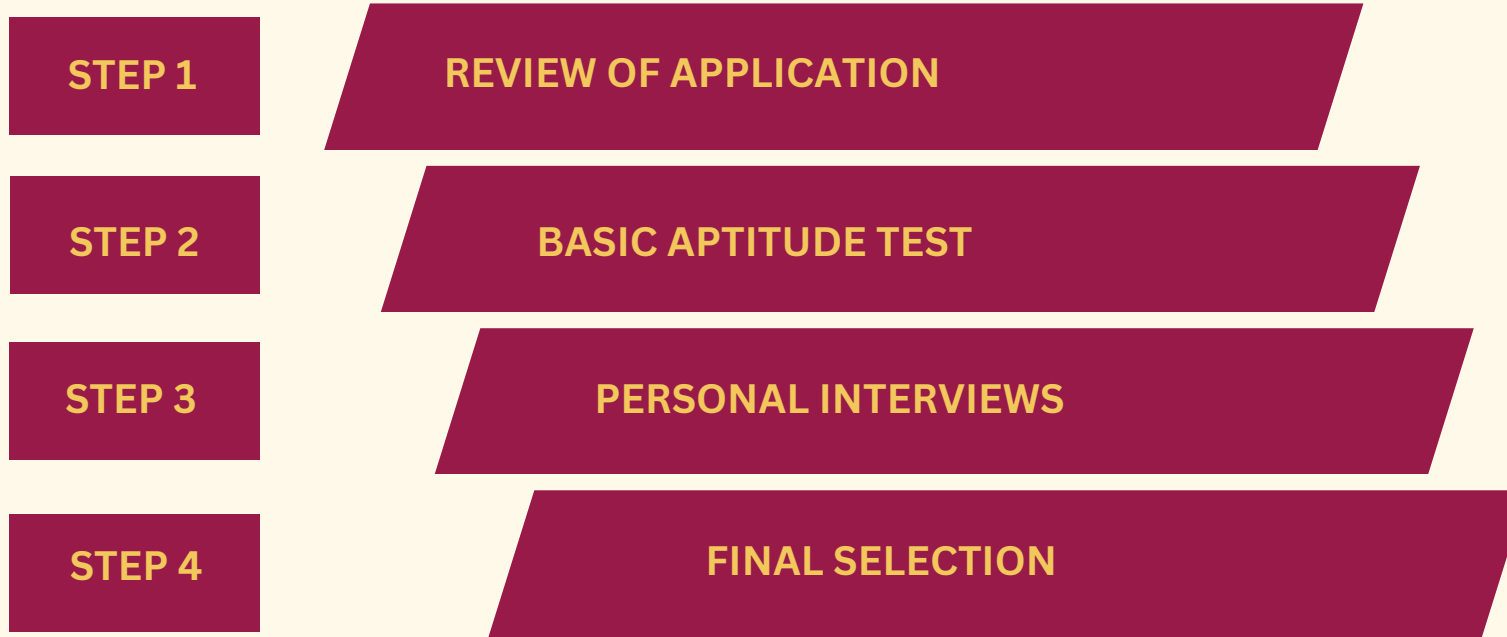
THE FEE FOR THE COURSE IS RS. 25,000/-
